POULTRY IN MISSOURI

Missouri agriculture is a powerful economic engine, and poultry remains one of its strongest sectors. In 2024 poultry and eggs contributed **\$2.03 billion** in cash receipts, with broilers accounting for more than half of that total at **\$1.07 billion**. This makes broilers a vital part of Missouri's agricultural success.



Poultry is the **2nd** most valuable live-stock commodity in Missouri.



Producers and processors of chicken, turkey and eggs along with companies that provide supplies to industry employ over **63,655 individuals** across the state.



Missouri **ranks 5th** in the nation for turkey production. In 2024, **15 million turkeys** were raised and processed for distribution across the nation.

POULTRY COMPANIES

Major integrators of broilers, turkeys and egg producers have multiple plant locations across the state of Missouri.



ALLIED COMPANIES

Companies that provide a product or service to the poultry industry are referred to as allied companies. Over ten companies are located within the state that offer feed and grain equipment, food processing equipment and supplies, feed ingredients, automation services, insurance, finance, consultation services, packaging and more.



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RANKS 11TH IN THE NATION FOR THE NUMBER OF BROILERS PRODUCED.

- Number of broilers raised: **266 million**
- Pounds Produced: **1.43 billion**
- Value of Production: **\$1.07 billion**
- The broiler industry creates and supports **45,472 jobs** in the state.
- In 2024, the industry was responsible for as much as **\$16.31 billion** in total economic activity throughout the state.
- Jobs in the industry pay an average of **\$64,800** in wages and benefits.

RANKS 5TH IN THE NATION FOR THE NUMBER OF TURKEYS PRODUCED.

- Number of turkeys raised: **15 million**
- Pounds Produced: **334 million**
- Value of Production: **\$187 million**
- The turkey industry creates and supports **15,340 jobs** in the state.
- In 2024, the industry was responsible for as much as **\$5.25 billion** in total economic activity throughout the state.
- Jobs in the industry pay an average of **\$60,100** in wages and benefits.

RANKS 8TH IN THE NATION FOR THE NUMBER OF EGGS PRODUCED.

- Number of eggs produced: **4.2 billion**
- Value of Production: **\$772 million**
- The egg industry creates and supports **2,843 jobs** in the state.
- In 2024, the industry was responsible for as much as **\$989.26 million** in total economic activity throughout the state.
- Jobs in the industry pay an average of **\$61,500** in wages and benefits.
